Wonderfully Made

Week 1: God Creates Man Day 1

Morning Prayer: Thank you God for creating us, we are grateful that we can be made in your image. Please guide us as we try to live our lives by your word. Thank you for all the beauty you have surrounded us with, and for these precious children here today. In Jesus name Amen.

Bible Verse: "Let us make man in our image..." Genesis 1:23

Bible Story: Using the Creation Felt Set, read to the children the story of Genesis 1, about the creation of the world. Focus on the creation of men and how we are created in God's image. Pass around a mirror and let children look to see their image.

ASK: What does image mean? What do you think God might be like? Do you think he loves his children?

Bible Activity: Put the words "God Made Me" on display so the children can see them. Read the words to the children, then tell them they are going to make an image of the letters. Use your body to make each letter, and have the children copy you.

Language: A is for Adam! Talk with children about the different sounds that "A" can make. "A" in Adam is short, "A" in Made is long. Provide "A" Coloring and Handwriting sheets for them to work on.

Bible Song: God Made Me

Bible Craft: Using the God Made Minibook, help children color and add in the different things that God has made. Listen to the Long A sound in the word made.
